* **FALL FUNDRAISER TIME**.....

Please text me asap to (334)313-2046 and I'll send you however many tickets you want to try to sell. Please text me with questions. In your text when ordering the tickets, please tell me where to mail the tickets. There is not another fundraiser out there that gives you up to 75% of the cut, and on top of that, you're supporting an organization that serves and supports the game of amateur baseball in this state like no other does. There is no obligation to sell all the tickets you order, however the more you sell, the greater profit your team earns (see chart below). Throw away the tickets you don't sell. You may order more if you sell what we initially send you. *We're offering a "car wash" ticket to sell with the same prizes offered, in case your higher ups don't want you participating in our fundraiser because by definition it's a game of chance. No game of chance here when they are getting a free car wash for their \$10 donation. You set the date of the car wash and tell the purchaser when and where it will be when they buy the ticket. A copy of each ticket is enclosed in this letter.*

* ***Please check with your Athletic Director and / or Principal to make sure you can participate in the fundraiser BEFORE ordering the tickets. DO NOT order them without their approval! Thank You.***

* ***Feel free to get any other team at your school or in your league to buddy with your team and participate.***

Have the folks who buy the tickets make the check out to your school/organization. Then you can cut the ALABCA our piece of the pie once you finish selling your tickets. The percentage we get is shown just below depending on how many tickets you sell. *Money and ticket stubs need to be in my hand by Friday, November 13* (the drawing is Sunday, November 15 - with or without your tickets, I'm drawing that day). Throw away the tickets you don't sell. When you return the tickets, please tell us how many tickets you sold. I'll send you a form to fill out and send in with your ticket stubs and our check. *DO NOT send the ALABCA checks from individuals,* only school checks. Thank you.

Thank you for your participation in the 19th Annual Alabama Baseball Coaches Association Fall Fundraiser. The basic goal is for you and your team to sell at least 300 tickets so you may receive the highest percentage of sales at 75% and so you, the head coach, may receive a free convention fee for the December 9-11, 2026 coaches gathering in Birmingham. Personally, I believe you and your team can sell 500+ tickets and really make some good money, however you have to have a plan to achieve this goal and beyond. From my experience in selling these tickets when I was a coach, and other high school coaches who have been highly successful in selling them, here are some basic thoughts/tips for you to ponder.....

- Put a minimum of 10 - 20 tickets per player. I'd say 20 but I'm used to pushing my guys when I had them do things.
- Tell them so much of what they sell is coming off the cost of their spirit pack.
- If they sell the minimum, they get their name in the hat for a drawing for
You pick the prize - dri-fit t-shirt, pair of batting gloves, etc.... Something simple and that they'd use, to help motivate them to get into the drawing. For every extra five tickets they sell they get their name in the hat again to have an extra shot(s) at winning.
- Have an overall top seller's winner prize - backpack, etc... something nicer.
- VERY IMPORTANT: Give them a certain time frame to sell them, like a month max, maybe three weeks, AND ... have a midway point where you expect to collect half their goal of what you're requiring them to sell (requiring = not optional). **Tighter time frame for a required goal = Urgency to achieve their Goal.**
- If you give them until first week of November (max time), and never check back with them, thinking, "Aw man, they have all this time to sell them, they'll easily sell them." Usually - NOT GONNA HAPPEN! They need motivating, and you're the motivator here.
And if you don't have a "midway turn in tickets sold to that point time," you're increasing the chance you're not going to achieve your goal. You're frustrated and embarrassed at the end, and you don't know why they didn't make the easy money this fundraiser seems to be.

I need your ticket stubs and ALABCA check in hand by Friday November 13. I'm drawing for the prizes November 15, with or without your ticket stubs. If you send them USPS mail them to: ALABCA, P.O. You and your players can sell 500+ tickets !! Set the bar high as you do with your on-field goals and team GPA goals, etc.... And keep your foot on the gas a little, as I explained above and it will happen! Myself, and others have done it, and not by accident.
