

- Head Baseball Coach at Davidson High School (Alma Mater) (Mobile, AL) 1975-1980
- · Mobile County Coach of the Year 1975
- 2 state titles back to back (79/80)
- 2 time state Coach of the Year (79/80)
- Head Baseball Coach Enterprise State Junior College 1981-1986
- Coached Jerome Walton (N.L. Rookie of the Year 1986) at Enterprise State
- · 1982 State Coach of the Year
- 2 Junior College state titles
- 1982 finished year ranked 9th in the country
- 56 players signed to play at the next level from Davidson High School/Enterprise Junior College
- · 1987 hired at South Alabama as pitching coach
