Named Wallace-Dothan's head coach at the beginning of the 1997-1998 baseball season, then added the title of Athletic Director in 2011; Has accumulated a record of 815-464 for a .637 winning percentage; Named ACCC Coach of the Year six times (2000, 2003, 2004, 2006, 2017, 2019), and also led the Gobs to the Regular Season Conference Championships in 2000, 2003, 2004, 2006, 2017, and 2021; Won NJCAA Region XXII Championship in 2017 and finished as ACCC Tournament runner-up seven times (2000, 2002, 2006, 2014, 2016, 2021, & 2022); Has increased overall team GPA by 37% over the past ten years (with two of his teams being named NJCAA Academic All-American Teams in the past 5 years); Grew up in Tallahassee, Florida where he attended Godby High School; One of top JUCO prospects in the Alabama area at Wallace-Dothan from 1981-1983 and led the Gobs to a State Championship in 1983; Signed with the San Francisco Giants organization after being drafted in the second round of the January free agent draft in 1984; Played three years in the Giants Minor League system, named Team MVP for all three years and Topps Minor League Player of the Year in 1985; Spent nine seasons in the MLB with the Giants, Pirates, Mets, and Mariners.
